# History

Hindustan Motors Limited is the ancestor to all automobile manufacturing companies of India. It was established in 1942 before India's independence. It was a flagship company of C.K. Birla group. Originally the company had a small assembling plant at Port Okha, Gujarat. Main purpose was to reduce transportation costs because all parts were imported from foreign companies. Later it was shifted to Uttarpara, West Bengal due to cheaper raw materials and low labor cost. This later resulted in one of the most successful motor cars of India, the ambassador.

Hindustan Motors manufactured the Ambassador and Landmaster motorcars (based on 1956 Morris Oxford series III), both immensely popular Indian automobiles, from 1957–2014.

One of the original three car manufacturers in India, founded in 1942 by Mr. B.M. Birla, it was a leader in car sales until the 1980s, when the industry was opened up from protection. All through its history, the company has depended on government patronage for its sales and for survival by eliminating competition.

# Evolution of Logo







The logo from it's initial days to now is what one can say 'simple', but 'iconic".

The TM is registered under the category of device mark under 12 category.

There is one difference and similarity as well in respect to the evolution of the logo of Hindustan Motors between the previous and the recent one.

The former and the latter logos have written Hindustan Motors in bold capital form and the short form of HM alongside. But the older logos do not have any color combinations or any design formation in the words. Wherein the latest logo, comprises a combination of yellow, dark blue and white color combination and the way 'HM' is written is also more modern and unique.

# Evolution of India's pride



From being the 'lal peeli' gaadi to the 'lal batti' gaadi, the Amdassabor was a true beacon of Indian indigenous automotive manufacturing. It was also recognized as a symbol of Swadeshi for the two following reasons, firstly it was entirely manufactured in India and lastly the Hindustan Motors was owned by the Birlas, an industrial house which played an active role in India's freedom movement.

It was in 2014 that Hindustan Motors finally ended the production of Ambassador, following a failed attempt at re-branding the car in a more compact and swanky version titled 'Amby.

Hindustan Motors currently does not own any trademark registrations related to the word 'Ambassador'. The earlier mark owned by HM was not renewed, and applications for the new mark bearing numbers 2803570 and 2803571 have been advertised with the opposition period getting over on February 9, 2017 and February 9, 2016 respectively and no opposition have been filed against the same. While the brand name awaits its revival, the iconic Ambassador brand (including its trademarks ) was sold for a sum equal to Rs.80 crore.

## India's - Desi Muscle Car

The Contessa or Conti was the country's first luxury sedan. It was a 'foreign-looking' stylish car that Indians craved for and especially those Indians who were stuck with domestic choices of a big, fat Ambassador or a basic Premier Padmini. But this was an affordable desi car with videshi pretensions.

Based on Vauxhall cars, the Contessa was Hindustan Motors' more upmarket alternative to the Ambassador at the turn of the last century. The sedan was introduced the in the 1980 and was continued till the 2000s.

The first application for the CONTESSA trademark was made in 1983. It can be observed that the first wordmark of CONTESSA is very modest as only bold and capital letters are there.

## Making a comeback?

If recent TM applications are to be believed, then YES! The iconic Indian sedan is on its way back to the market as the company has executed a brand transfer agreement with SG Corporate Mobility Pvt Ltd on June 16, 2022 for the transfer of the Contessa brand, including the trademarks having application number and certain related rights of the brand, Hindustan Motors. The transfer of the brand shall be effective upon fulfillment of the terms and conditions as prescribed in the agreement. Hindustan Motors have recently trademarked the iconic 'Contessa' name.
